



Eigenberg Joins Sioux Valley Energy Board of Directors

Colman, S.D. – Kevin Eigenberg, Brandon, was selected to represent the Brandon-Valley Springs area on the Sioux Valley Energy board of directors. Former District 8 board member, Cliff Nock resigned in July due to illness. A special committee made up of currently seated board members recommended Eigenberg’s name to fill Nock’s unexpired term which will end in 2011.
